Born and raised in Les Cayes, Haiti, Anderson attended the American University of the Caribbean in Les Cayes where he received his Bachelor of Sciences in Agroforestry and Environmental Sciences.

Anderson has completed research projects on numerous endangered species throughout Haiti as part of his foundation, Jeunes en Action pour la Sauvegarde de l'Écologie en Haïti (JACSEH). He was a former staff member for the Société Audubon Haiti. Anderson has worked for EPIC since 2013 and currently lives with his wife and children in his home country of Haiti.
